24 HOUR CARE is typically delivered in two twelve hour shifts which are done by two different caregivers. One aide comes to the home from 8am until 8pm and is relieved by the second caregiver at 8pm until 8am, although the shift times are flexible. A live in caregiver is expected to be awake all day and have at least 8 hours of sleep at night, so if you need assistance regularly during the night, a live in arrangement will not work.

- ◆ Who need to be turned at least every two hours at night
- ◆ Who need assistance with toileting frequently at night
- ◆ Suffering from Alzheimer's and are prone to wandering
- ◆ Restless at night and need assistance frequently

- ◆ Who have anxiety and/or panic at night
